Loan move discussed for Wednesday midfielder as transfer window enters last month

Sheffield Wednesday has had a busy summer under manager Danny Röhl, with nine new players joining the first team and more to come. The need to trim down the squad could include finding temporary homes for young players who will have limited game time this season. Rio Shipston, a midfielder who has been part of the Owls' preseason at S6, St. George's Park and Germany, has been discussed as a potential loan move away from the club to further his development. Other young players such as Pierce Charles and Bailey Cadamarteri are also being considered for loan deals.

Sheffield, England, has a long list of beautiful spots for summer, including The Rocking Rock in Rivelin Valley, Meersbrook Park, Endcliffe Park, and more. The city is also home to nature walks that other cities could only dream of, with many within 15 minutes of travelling from city centre. The Rocker Rock is accessible from Rivelin Valley car park and is a massive stony outcrop as big as my living room to sit on with an unparalleled view over Rivel Valley. Endcliffe park is full of secrets, with several parks for families, a park, a cafe, a gentle river, two duck ponds, a woods to explore and a sweeping hill of beautiful, mature trees.

William Osula cheat sheet: 10 things to know about incoming Newcastle signing

Newcastle United is in talks to sign 20-year-old Danish forward William Osula from Sheffield United. Osula, who was born in Denmark to a Danish mother and Nigerian father in 2003, is expected to return to Premier League action sooner than anticipated. Despite not being yet a household name, Osula's arrival has surprised some by surprise. His career began at Sheffield United six years ago and he settled into English football by spending years in the Bramall Lane academy. He made his professional debut in March 2022 and has been a regular for his country's under 21 side. Despite a disappointing season at Derby, Osulas has been praised for his goalscoring form.

Go Quest Adventures launched Sheffield immersive trail with 30% off during August

Go Quest Adventures, a self-guided city trail company, has launched its latest Quest in Sheffield, offering a 30% discount for bookings during August. The immersive 'Quest' encourages outdoor teamwork among groups of all sizes and offers clues, hidden heritage, interesting facts and challenges. The interactive two-three hour experience is accessed via a free app with a competitive leaderboard and monthly prizes. It costs £28.95 per Quest for teams of 1-5 players, with larger groups advised to divide into multiple teams and purchase one Quest per team. The company also offers individually tailored Quests for corporate team building, schools, universities, and special events.

Sheffield Botanical Gardens an 'educational centerpiece for the region'

Sheffield Botanical Gardens has completed its education and engagement project, receiving £144k from The National Lottery Heritage Fund for an Education and Engagement Project at Sheffield Botanical Garden. The project was led by the Friends of the Botanical Gardens, Sheffield Garden Trust, and Sheffield City Council, with £16k of match funding. The funding has allowed the site to become an 'educational centerpiece' for the city and region, with extensive education programmes developed for local schools and adults. New interpretation signage has been

installed across the gardens to help visitors understand the range of plants and flora on site. This year also marks the 40th anniversary of the Friends' (FOBS).

United make Dozzell transfer decision after ex-QPR man's Bramall Lane trial spell

Sheffield United has made a decision to not sign midfielder Andre Dozzell for the final pre-season friendly against Huddersfield Town. The midfielder, who was on trial with the Blades this summer after his release by Queens Park Rangers, impressed with his composed performance and goal. However, a decision was made to allow him to continue his search for a new club. This comes amid uncertainty about the future of Vini Souza and concerns that Gus Hamer may be snatched away before the start of the new season. Tom Davies will miss the season due to a hamstring issue and Hamer has operated on the left of United's midfield in pre-Season.

Tour of Britain cycling race to pass through South Yorkshire as route confirmed

The Tour Of Britain cycling race will return to South Yorkshire for the first time in 17 years, with the 20th edition of Britain's biggest professional cycle race set to pass through South Yorkshire on September 5. The race will begin in Sheffield, passing through Rotherham and Doncaster before finishing in Barnsley. The total route will cover more than 103 miles and will begin on Arundel Gate in Sheffield City Centre and cover over 103 miles before ending on County Way. The first categorised King of the Mountains climb will occur on Long Lane, a one-kilometre climb averaging almost nine per cent, which was climbed by the Tour de France in 2014. The route highlights the diversity of the Rotherham borough, highlighting the increasing number of residents cycling in the borough.

Liverpool FC's 2024/25 Away Kit Is a Tribute to the Hillsborough Disaster

Liverpool Football Club has revealed its new 2024/25 away kit as a tribute to the 1989 Hillsborough disaster. The kit will be outfitted in black and teal hues and features rounded collars and contrasting sleeve cuffs. Nike's sponsorship logo is on the right chest, while Standard Chartered's logo shines on the center. The "Night Forest"-hued kit is contrasted by teal shoulder pipping, and crossed torches are ignited at the rear

beside "97" numerals. The lightweight kit is designed for summertime and features sweat-resistant Dri-Fit ADV technology for athletes and fanatics alike.

Supertram's improvements under public ownership

The South Yorkshire Mayoral Combined Authority (SYMCA) is investing over £33 million into the tram network, with over £23 million expected this financial year alone. This investment is part of a wider effort to deliver a world-class tram network for the region, connecting all communities to opportunity. Since March, 20,000 people have already downloaded a new app to buy tickets and new handheld ticketing machines have been installed. The second phase of summer Supertram investment will begin with VolkerRail performing works at Hollinsend, Ridgeway Road and Herdings.

Liam Palmer discusses retirement with statement that Sheffield Wednesday fans will love

Sheffield Wednesday veteran Liam Palmer has expressed his intention to retire from professional football, but only a few years down the line yet. Palmer, who signed a new contract with the club earlier this summer, has made 436 total appearances for Sheffield Wednesday, ranking 8th in the club's all-time appearance list. He will participate in his testimonial match with Spanish outfit Leganes, which is also Sheffield Wednesday's final pre-season friendly. Despite his retirement, Palmer remains a significant player for the club and hopes to finish his career with Sheffield Wednesday.
